

ORDINANCE NO. 468

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING RESTRICTIONS WITHIN
THE VILLAGE OF EASTON, MASON COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Easton, Mason County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: It is unlawful to park any vehicle, or to permit any vehicle to stand or park, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer, in any of the following places:

- (A) In front of a public or private driveway;
- (B) Within an intersection;
- (C) Within fifteen (15) feet of any fire hydrant;
- (D) Within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- (E) Within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic control sign located on the side of the roadway;
- (F) Within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station, and on the side of the street opposite to the entrance to any fire station within seventy-five (75) feet of such entrance, (when properly sign posted);
- (G) At any place within the Village where official signs prohibit standing or parking; or
- (H) Across, upon or within the right-of-way of any sidewalk.

SECTION 2: Truck Parking Prohibited-Where.

- (A) It is unlawful to permit:
 - 1. Any truck tractor, semitrailer, or any combination thereof;
 - 2. Any vehicle exceeding 22 feet in length, excepting RV's, campers and motor homes,

3. Any vehicle with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 20,000 pounds;
or
4. Any vehicle designed, used, or maintained for towing, hauling, or carrying other motor vehicles or equipment;

to stand or be parked on any street, alley, private road, public driveway, or upon any public property which is within areas zoned R-1 or R-2 (Residential) by the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Easton, except when said vehicle is actively loading or unloading, or the owner of the truck is repairing or doing construction work upon the premises, and the truck is needed in the performance of that work.

(B) Notwithstanding subsection A above, it shall be permissible for a truck tractor (without a temporary or semitrailer attached) to be parked upon the owner or operator's own property so long as such is parked upon a paved or gravel driveway and is not obstructing any sidewalk or other public right of way.

SECTION 3: It is unlawful for any truck tractor engines, auxiliary motors, accessory generators, refrigerator units, compressors, or automated power units (APU), on any truck or trailer, to be idling within three hundred (300) feet of a residence, except when said vehicle or trailer is being loaded or unloaded, or when maintenance or service is being performed on such vehicle or trailer.

SECTION 4: **Motor Home/Camper Parking Prohibited.** It is unlawful for any motor home, camper or travel trailer to be parked upon any public or private property within the Village limits, unless such has a valid license plate and current registration sticker affixed thereto.

SECTION 5: **Penalty.** Any person, firm or entity violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined a minimum of \$250.00 and the maximum of

\$750.00, and it shall be deemed a separate and distinct offense for each day said violation is allowed to continue.

This Ordinance was passed by the Village Board on May 7, 2018, 2018, and shall be in full force and effect after the passage and publication as required by law.


