

RESOLUTION NO. 499

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SHORT-TERM AND HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF EASTON, MASON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Easton has control over the public parking designations upon the Village streets located within the Village limits of said Village of Easton, Mason County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Easton has the authority, as it deems appropriate, to designate certain parking spaces as and for short-term parking and handicapped parking, and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Easton deems it in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Easton, that three parking spaces immediately adjacent to the Easton Community Bank and one parking space on the south side of Illinois Route 10 directly south of said Easton Community Bank, be restricted and designated as short-term parking spaces and that one parking space immediately adjacent to the Easton Community Bank be restricted and designated as a handicapped parking space, to enable the public to perform business with said bank.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Easton, Mason County, Illinois as follows:


1. That there is hereby designated and restricted three parking spaces designated as short-term parking, not to be utilized by anyone for more than a fifteen-minute period, located immediately adjacent to the Community Bank of Easton.
2. That there is hereby designated and restricted one parking space designated as a short-term parking space, not to be utilized by anyone for more than a

fifteen-minute period, located on the south side of Illinois Route 10 directly south of the Easton Community Bank.

3. That there is hereby designated and restricted one parking space designated as a handicapped parking space located immediately adjacent to the Easton Community Bank.

4. That the Director of Public Works, or any other official designated by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Easton, is hereby directed and authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to so designate said parking spaces, mark them appropriately, and place the appropriate signage to designate and restrict said parking spaces as and for short-term parking and handicapped parking, respectively; and thereafter said spaces shall be restricted and used for the designated purpose only, and enforced as such in accordance with the law.

This Resolution was passed by the President and Board of Trustees on October 2nd 2023, and shall be in full force and effect after the passage and publication as required by law.
